PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project connected the owner's existing three story building to two smaller independent buildings with infill construction between each and tied together with a new façade. One of the infills created a new entry way for the complex that accommodated a new ramp and elevator into the existing building. The two connected buildings created new clinical space, offices, and a resource center which included a public loan braille library. All aspects of the project were designed with sensitivity for those people who are blind or visually impaired.
