PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Rochester Educational Opportunity Center (REOC), previously housed in three separate locations throughout the city, is a tuition free education program offering short-term general education diploma, college preparation, and vocational certification programs for inner city low income adults. This new \$12 million adaptive reuse LEED certified project consolidates the locations in nearly double the square footage to provide a modern, spacious facility for the REOC programs. The 125,000 SF facility includes offices, state-of-the art classrooms, a 500-seat multipurpose area, nursing laboratories, a cosmetology salon, and culinary bistro among other specific program spaces.



PARTICIPATION

As Capital Projects Coordinator for the SUNY College at Brockport, (the sponsor of the REOC), David Strabel was responsible for coordinating design and construction activities with the consolidation of the REOC programs into the new building, including acquisition and implementation of all of the furnishings and equipment, and the management of the moves.
